Growth of AUD \$100,000



Fund commentary

- Key positive contributors to July performance included energy holdings Stanmore Resources and Coronado Resources. Both stocks traded higher as production disruptions at peer miners mean supply dynamics are more favourable for metallurgical coal. International financials Apollo and ING Groep also performed well.
- Key detractors to July performance included Woodside Energy and BHP.
- The portfolio was largely unchanged throughout July. Small changes included adding to Centuria Industrial REIT and slightly trimming Stanmore Resources following strong performance in the first half of the month. Stanmore subsequently gave up some of the share price appreciation due to macro concerns.
- At month end, the Fund's net equity position was 78% with an additional 16% in credit securities.
