

# Monthly Update

## Fund commentary

- US trade talks head for the end zone, UK politicians drop the ball.
- NAB income securities find further support thanks to CBA.
- Irish eyes are smiling.

Markets remained buoyant in March as the US Federal Reserve continued to indicate that interest rates are on hold for the time being. Additionally, trade talks between the US and China appear to have progressed further. The biggest unknown facing markets at the moment is Brexit which seems to have stalled as UK politicians do their best to fumble the process.

Our holding in NAB's listed income securities performed well once again, as markets continue to speculate about a possible redemption of this bond post the CBA announcing they were calling a similarly structured bond in February.

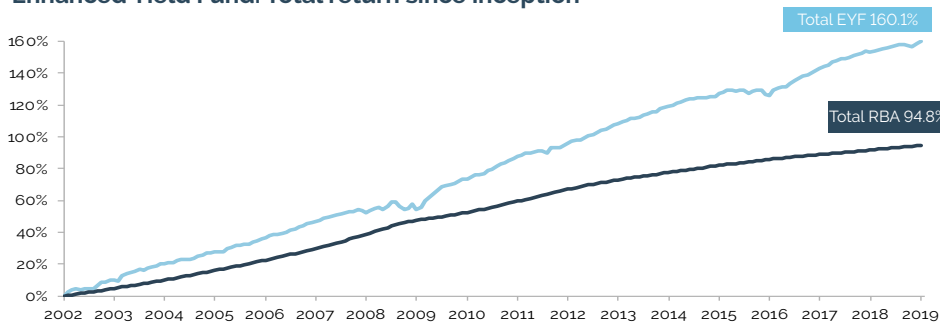
Our investments themed around the recovery in Irish residential property also performed well, with property prices

finding further support from favourable demand dynamics, as well as a supportive environment for credit growth. Our holdings in Allied Irish Bank and homebuilders Cairn Homes and Glenveagh Properties all contributed meaningfully to performance.

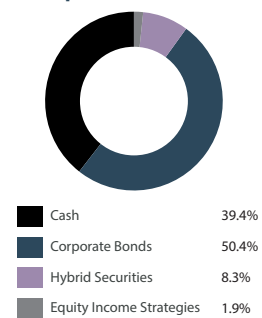
Our holding in the senior secured bonds of Spanish commercial property company Lar Espana was weaker over the month, as the company announced a special dividend to equity holders post an asset sale. We believe the business is still appropriately geared given its asset quality, and at a spread of ~4% over cash (\$A yield of ~5.75%) we are comfortable holding our investment.

### Investment philosophy

We aim to build long term wealth together with our co-investors by finding and exploiting investment anomalies around the world. Using a focused, patient and considered approach to finding simple investment ideas produces the best environment for creating that long term wealth.

Our experience has shown us that while the market is largely efficient, it can, and regularly does, misprice a small proportion of companies. This mispricing can arise as a result of any number of reasons, but is most often associated with disruptive or cyclical change, new information which is misunderstood by the market as having a permanent impact when it is in fact transitory, or just because they are operating in a sector out of favour with investors.

Our unique process is based on scanning the world for those companies (hence the radar in our logo), discovering the associated valuation anomalies and extracting value from them. We buy good businesses at a good price; businesses that we believe are being valued differently to their long term intrinsic value, but will return to their correct value over time.

### Who manages the investment?

Jarod Dawson is the Portfolio Manager and has been managing the portfolio since 2004. Assisted by John Whelan, together they have over 36 years' combined industry experience. Jarod and John are also supported by the broader investment team, with Paul Moore as CIO who has over 32 years' experience in successfully managing investment funds.

The Fund's process is effective and repeatable, based on an effective philosophy.
