### Growth of AUD \$100,000

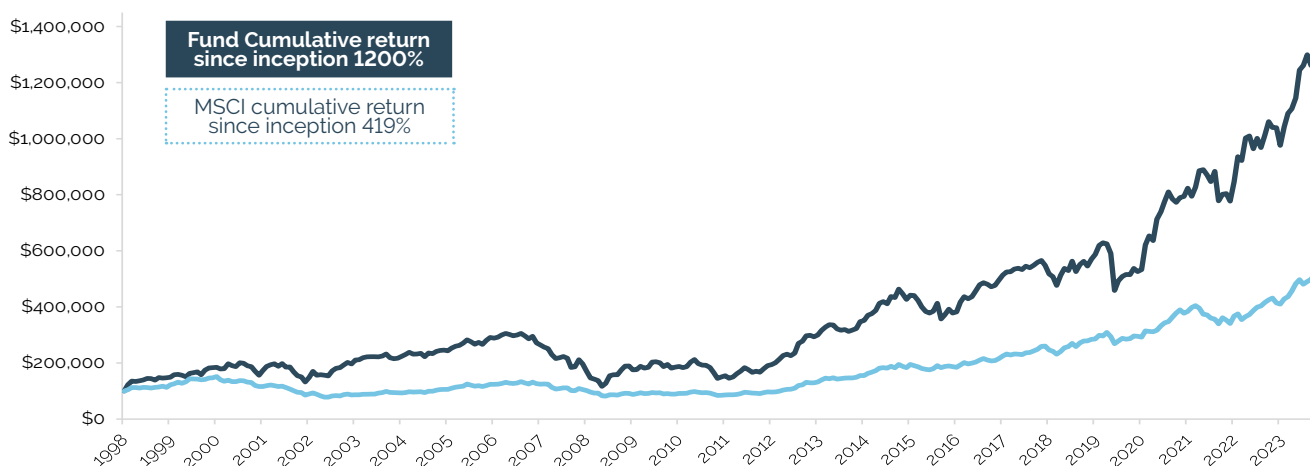



## Fund commentary

- Key contributors to July performance included European bank holdings CaixaBank and Lloyds, and homebuilder Cairn Homes.
- Key detractors to July performance included oil company CNOOC, Freeport McMoran copper, and our Macau gaming holdings. Currency movements were also unfavourable with the Australian dollar weakening against both the US dollar and Euro.
- The Fund added to existing positions in Airbus, Fox Corp, Wynn Macau and Sands China. The Fund also exited its short position in McDonald's Corp, a position we've held for some time now. The stock has been flat to down over a three-year period and earnings have grown into the high valuation. We no longer believe the risk reward on the short is compelling and thus exited at sub \$250 dollars per share.
