## **Company commentary**

• The COVID-19 pandemic remained the predominant driver of the portfolio's underlying holdings, both positive and negative

Growing concerns around an uptick in COVID-19 cases in the US had a negative impact on Wynn Resorts, with investors contemplating a potential slowing of the reopening measures implemented during May and even the potential for movement restrictions to be reinstated. Other Macau holdings were less impacted by this given their lack of US exposure.

An outbreak of COVID-19 in Beijing also negatively impacted the likes of TravelSky Technologies. However, a rapid response from authorities and a testing blitz looks to have brought this outbreak under control.

Conversely, the portfolio's copper holdings continued to advance in line with the copper price, as investors

positioned for further supply outages across South America, particularly in Chile, where authorities have yet to bring infections under control and unions have threatened to remove members from mine sites. Chile is the world's largest copper producer, accounting for over 25% of global supply.

We are continuing to take advantage of the severe dislocations over the past six months. Several small positions were exited during June, with the capital rotated into China Mobile, TravelSky Technology, Kunlun Energy and Melco Resorts & Entertainment.
